■ 1 Church:

Built in 1960.

Location where all parish masses, funerals, baptisms, reconciliation services and other liturgical events take place. It is also where the Parish Library is located.

■ 5 Amphitheater/ Playground:

Built in 2012.

A place to play for young and "young at heart"!

■ 6 OLG School Pre K-8 and Parish Hall:

Built in 1962.

OLG classrooms for preschool through eighth grade. Also the location of the Parish School Hall. SW Myrtle Street is closed during school hours.

■ 2 Parish Life Center & Archbishop Brunett Gym:

Built in 2012.

Location for CYO sports and other gymnasium events, funeral and wedding receptions, stage and drama productions, and events for large gatherings.

■ 3 Pastoral Center:

Built in 2009.

Parish Offices (including the Pastor), the Our Lady of Guadalupe and the Juan Diego meeting room, and the Conference Room.

■ 4 NE Garden Terrace:

Outdoor classroom garden beds for OLG School & The Giving Garden, which provides food for the local food banks. Also, garden beds available to the community.
